GIVEN FOR YOU; WONDROUS GRACE FOR UNSETTLED HEARTS

The world around us often feels shaky. Between the headlines and the heartaches, it is easy to feel unsettled and confused. This Lent, we step into the quiet of the Upper Room and the deep, dramatic waters of the Gospels to find a different story.

Using a rhythmic pattern of long-form scripture, "wondering" reflection, and intentional silence, we will explore five powerful narratives where Jesus meets people in their own chaotic moments—from a lonely well in Samaria to a tomb in Bethany. Throughout these five weeks, we will witness how Christ consistently hands over his presence, his peace, and his love to those who are most restless.

This journey leads us directly to the Table. Our series culminates on Maundy Thursday, as we witness our First Communion students receive the holy meal for the very first time. On that night, the "wondrous grace" we have studied becomes a tangible promise for all of us: *the body and blood of Christ, given for you.*

Come and discover that even when the world is at its most unsettled, Christ's grace remains steady, wondrous, and forever given.
